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Section 1009.46(1), Florida Statutes, states that:

Each postsecondary educational institution that receives state funds for state financial aid and tuition assistance programs shall:

(a) Complete and return the **annual application** for state aid funds in the format and by the date established by the Department of Education.

(b) Maintain complete, accurate, and auditable student records documenting the institution's administration of state financial aid and tuition assistance funds. (c) Verify eligibility of enrolledstudents with the department eachacademic term.

(d) **Report each student's program of study** to the department using the most recent classification of instructional programs taxonomy for the certificate or degree level as developed by the United States Department of Education's National Center for Education Statistics.



(e) **Disburse state financial aid** and tuition assistance to eligible students.

(f) **Notify students** annually regarding the renewal requirements for each state-funded award for which they are eligible. (g) **Complete and return to the department all reports** for the administration of state funds in the format and by the date established by the department.

(h) Complete and return to the department all legislatively required reports in the format and by the date established by the department.



(i) **Retain required records** for the later of 5 years or until such records are audited and any audit exceptions are resolved.

- (j) **Refund to the department** any undisbursed advances:
 - 1. Within 60 days after the end of the regular registration period each fall and spring term,
 - 2. Within 30 days after the end of the summer term, or
 - 3. Within 60 days after the date a student's ineligibility is determined.



An institution that **fails to perform its duties** in administering state financial aid or tuition assistance programs could be placed on probation by the department.

(a) The department may provide allocations on a **reimbursement basis** to a participating institution that fails to timely remit undisbursed funds for the previous academic year.

(b) The department **may suspend or revoke an institution's eligibility** to participate in state-funded programs if the institution fails to provide the required audits, fails to resolve audit findings, or fails to timely provide statutorily required reports by established deadlines.

- Students may conditionally be funded for less than half-time enrollment permitting that:
 - The remaining hours of scholarship are disbursed, or
 - There are no remaining courses to enroll in for the program of study.

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E19 – ALREADY DISBURSED FOR ANOTHER BF/FSAG PROGRAM

- May be the result of a student that upgraded their Bright Futures program of eligibility between a submission in a prior term and the current submission.
- Typically, this occurs when an initial student is made eligible for BFFMS and receives a Summer Term 0 disbursement and then submits missing qualifying information to allow the student to become eligible for BFFAS.
- An FSAG student may have already been reported as being disbursed at the same institution for another FSAG program (FSAG/FSAGCE; e.g. FCS institutions)
- Resolution: Review the previously disbursed record for accuracy and adjust accordingly by cancelling the original award and disbursing the award under the correct program.
- Commonly Affected Program(s)*: BF, FSAG

- Summer Term 6 DER is typically during the second week of August
- An institution that receives funds from the program for the summer term shall remit to the department any undisbursed advances within 30 days after the end of the summer term



Process & Deadlines

Florida Student Assistance Grant (FSAG)

- Each semester term allocation will represent 50% of the total annual allocation.
- Report all eligible students, including all 'otherwise eligible' (C99) students, to OSFA within thirty (30) days of the end of the institution's regular registration period for each term.

Dual Enrollment Scholarship (DES) Program

- The deadline to submit reimbursement requests is no later than 30 days after the end of the regular registration period.
- The date listed as the Last Day of Drop/Add from your 2023-24 Postsecondary Institution Renewal Application will be used, per term, to define the 30-day period.
- Postsecondary institution users should continue to use the Reimbursement Request Report (RRR) to disburse DES records.
- Permitting available funds, there may be an ability to request reimbursement for missed disbursements in elapsed terms after the summer 2024 payout concludes.

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Deadlines

Schools failing to meet the statutory deadlines for returning funds shall be provided program funds on a reimbursement basis the following academic year.
